Featured Workshops

- Duck, Duck, Octopus: Improv for Inclusive Game Design — Use improv to design games and mechanics that welcome diverse players.
- Fighting with Your Fear Response — Trauma-informed tools for martial arts instructors to recognize and respond to fear in training.
- What's Up Danger? — Explore what happens when safety tools fail, and how to build resilient systems of care in emergent play.
- The Technologies of Magic — Investigate rituals and practices as technologies of connection, healing, and transformation.
- Rot Witch: The Desecrated Sacred — Reclaim abandoned or polluted spaces — and overlooked parts of ourselves — as sacred sites.
